School Cancellations

Here's the way school cancellations work: The superintendent of schools determines whether school should be held, delayed, or canceled. He notifies the principal and local radio and television stations. Parents are advised to listen carefully for announcements over the radio or the television stations. Sedgwick is part of School Union 76, which also includes Brooklin and Deer Isle-Stonington. Union 76 does not include George Stevens Academy,

although there is some communication between them.

So that his line can remain open for contacts, please do not call the principal at home to find out about school closures or delays. Also, if school needs to be dismissed before the end of the school day, we will make every effort to contact parents at the numbers provided on your child's emergency card (therefore, it is important to notify the school office about any phone number changes). Also, due to the number of calls to make, it is helpful for parents to listen to the radio or call the school in case of an early dismissal.
