To: Cynthia Reilly, a resident of the Town of Sedgwick, in said County, State of Maine

Greetings: You are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters of the Town of Sedgwick in said County of the referendum election described in this warrant.

To The Voters of the Town of Sedgwick:

You are hereby notified that a school budget validation referendum election will be held at the Sedgwick Town House in the Town of Sedgwick on May 16, 2008, at 1:00 p.m. for the purpose of determining the following article:

Article 1: Do you favor approving the Town of Sedgwick school budget for the upcoming school year that was adopted at the Special Town Meeting on May 15, 2008, and that includes locally raised funds that exceed the required local contribution as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act?

A YES vote allows additional funds to be raised for K-12 public education.

A NO vote means additional funds cannot be raised for K-12 public education.

The voting on Article 1 shall be by secret ballot referendum and the polls shall be opened at 1:00 pm and closed at 6:00 p.m.

The Registrar of Voters shall hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list; to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.
