



## El El Frijoles Burrito Night to benefit Sedgwick School's Technology Program

Mexican restaurant El El Frijoles announces today that it will hold a special Burrito Night on Friday, March 13<sup>th</sup> from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., and that 10% of the proceeds from this special event will go to the Sedgwick School as a donation to help fund their Technology Program.

The Taqueria, located at 41 Caterpillar Hill Road (Route 15) in Sargentville, is generally closed for the Winter months, but periodically opens it's doors for special events in the off-season. The Burrito Night event will feature a limited menu consisting of the taqueria's popular California-style burritos, fresh house-made salsas and a selection of dessert offerings.

As a special offering, El EL Frijoles will be producing "Freezer Packs" of their popular burritos in convenient bags of 6 that are ready to be popped into a freezer. Burritos are an ideal freezer food, as they keep exceptionally well, and are easy to re-heat and serve at the diner's convenience. The freezer packs as well as ready to eat burritos will need to be ordered in advance for preparation and pick-up during the Burrito Night event.

The Sedgwick School is currently working with an anonymous donor who has generously offered a matching grant of \$6000 to fund updates to the school's technology infrastructure. As this is a matching grant, the school must raise \$6000 on it's own in order to receive the full grant from the donor. In an effort to meet this fund raising goal, EL EL Frijoles will make a cash donation to the school's technology program of 10% of the total sales from this March 13<sup>th</sup> event.
