Budget

Sedgwick Elementary School faces significant budget cuts due to anticipated reductions in state subsidy. Dr. Buckingham prepared a five page memo for the board outlining in some detail the suggested areas to be cut after discussions with staff and parents. At the last school committee meeting the principal presented a list of areas to be cut if the need materialized. These cuts alter the current program and staffing, but may be necessary if there is a significant loss of state subsidy. Staff reductions included combining grades 3 & 4 and 1 & 2 next year and reducing custodial and library time to lower levels. These would be in addition to cuts made to guidance, library, special education, administration and other areas in this school year.
