Applicant criteria: Applicant must be a parent or person with the lived experience of raising a child with emotional/behavioral health issues.

Training includes: Certificate of Attendance in each of the 11 Domain Areas (2 hrs each domain =22 hrs total) as set forth by the National Certification Commission for Family Support <u>www.ffcmh.org</u> and as required for Maine certification of parent peers who support families and youth in Behavioral Health Homes.
