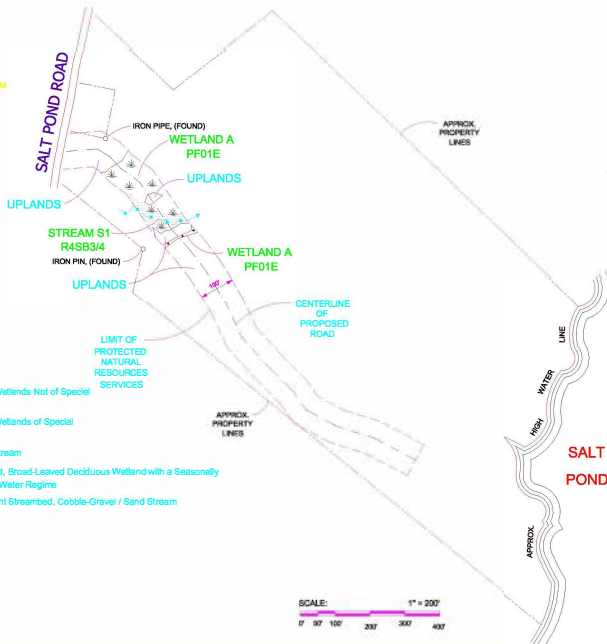




GR NORTH-MAINE STATE COORDINATE SYSTEM EAST ZONE NAD 83
