ARTICLES:

1. To choose a Moderator to preside over said meeting.


2. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to enter into and adopt the Rural Broadband Access Corporation Interlocal Agreement Concerning Open-Access Fiber Optic Networks, substantially in the form presented to this Town Meeting and that has been on file in the Town Clerk's Office, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference, with such modifications and changes to the dates, terms, and deadlines, and other details as the Board of Selectmen shall determine, and to form the Rural Broadband Access Corporation as anticipated by said Agreement, and to authorize the Selectmen to authorize said Corporation to acquire, lease and sell property in furtherance of its purposes, to raise revenue per the terms of the Agreement, and to issue one or more revenue bonds in accordance with 30-A M.R.S. § 2203(9) and the Agreement.

3. To see if the town will vote to appropriate \$10,000 from surplus for Administration.
